- Parentline ensures that fundraising staff/volunteers are provided with information and training on “The Guidelines” and its implementation.
- Parentline has a feedback and complaints procedure consistent with “The Guidelines”.

- Parentline prepares financial reports consistent with the requirements of the Charities Act 2009 and the Charities Regulator which include a statement concerning the extent to which control of the organisation is independent of its funding sources.
- Parentline ensures that all donations are tracked and recorded and complies with data protection requirements.
